

5 SIGNS YOUR STARTER OR ALTERNATOR IS ABOUT TO FAIL

When a forklift won't start, work stops. And when work stops, money bleeds. Starters and alternators don't often get attention until they fail – but smart fleet managers know the warning signs. Catch these early, and you can swap parts before your trucks stall out.

Slow or Hard Starts

If your truck cranks sluggishly or takes multiple attempts to fire up, the starter could be on its last leg. Don't assume it's just the battery - a weak starter is often the real culprit.

Dim or Flickering Lights

Alternators keep your truck's electrical systems powered. If you notice headlights, dash lights, or other accessories dimming, it's a red flag that the alternator isn't pulling its weight.

Frequent Jump Starts

A forklift that constantly needs a boost probably has more than a weak battery. Faulty alternators fail to keep batteries charged, leaving your fleet stranded.

Unusual Noises

Grinding, clicking, or whining when starting up? Those sounds are your starter begging for retirement. Ignoring them can lead to sudden failure — and downtime you can't afford.

Warning Lights on the Dash

Modern trucks tell you when something's wrong. Battery or charging system warning lights often point straight to alternator trouble. Treat them as early alerts, not suggestions.
